
- ♦ The site continues to be a key repository for resources for the Cause.
- More printable resources were added and in a range of languages, thanks to the help of translators, mostly CCN members.
- ♦ The relaxation of Covid-19 restrictions allowed resumption of travel to Brisbane, Qld, for technical sessions with our web host.
- ♦ Some development and simplification of the site took place during 2022 to be continued in 2023.

Other resources

- Liturgical resources to support Colinian and other Marist Anniversaries were upgraded and further translations made.
- ♦ The 'Short Life of Jean-Claude Colin' has been translated into German by Alois Greiler. Plans are under way for a Portuguese version.

Resource enquiries

- ♦ There have been a small number of requests to which I have responded by sending packs of language-specific material, and advising of the present protocols forbidding distribution of relics pre-Beatification.
- ♦ A copy of A Short Life of J-C Colin and the Colin Calendar are now included in the packs, as well as updated Prayers for Graces through the intercession of J-C Colin' and Praying for a miracle'.



Colin Calendars

- ♦ 700 copies of the 2022 calendar were produced although distribution was impacted to some extent by Covid.
- ♦ The calendar for 2023 is the tenth annual issue.
- ♦ It's theme of Jean-Claude Colin and Prayer' features texts chosen by Marists, young and older, throughout the Society.
- Work started earlier than in previous years, in anticipation of Covid-related international mailing issues.
- Over 1,000 copies were distributed in seven languages (English, Dutch, French, German, Italian, Spanish & Portuguese) and in two sizes.
- ♦ Copies were sent to:
 - * Each member of the Society (languagespecific, mostly through Unit centres)
 - * CCN members
 - * Formation communities
 - * General Administration
 - * Australian Lay Marist leaders and other Marist Family members
 - * Others on request

- ♦ The calendar features illustrations of places in the life of Jean-Claude Colin where he is likely to have prayed, each with a monthly quotation on prayer.
- ♦ It now contains weekly and principal liturgical dates and continues to highlight various Marist anniversaries.
- ♦ Even with express international postage the distribution cost per unit remains modest.

Liaison with Unit leaders & General Administration

- ♦ There appears to be good support from most Unit leaders for CCN members and their work.
- ♦ At the request of the Superior-General, a video report on *'Spreading the Fama'* was prepared for CS 2022.
- ♦ Regular Zoom and email contact with Ben McKenna has been of special help, as has periodic feedback from the General Council. I am grateful for the ongoing support of the Council and the ready availability of Ben with practical ideas and encouragement. He has provided updates on the advancement of the Cause in our Zoom sessions, including a summary report from Fr Carlo-Maria's Postulator's report to CS 2022.

Cost sharing & finances

Expenses of Colin Cause work continue to be shared with local ministry budgets in Australia, including:

- ♦ Internet & phone
- ♦ hardware & software
- ♦ stationery & consumables
- networking and other administrative services
- ♦ web consultation & professional in-services
- ♦ Colin calendar production and international mailing were amongst the main costs for 2022, as well as interstate travel for web consultations and in -services.

A separate expenditure summary with commentary has been prepared for the General Bursar.
