Week 29

'Let them hold all covetousness in horror. Yes, indeed, may we abhor this spirit. I have seen in the rules of certain congregations that they should strive to win over people in high places. Week 30

'Let us put on Jesus Christ, to that end working with all our heart so that Jesus Christ will work with us. We must put the man in us aside, and so ask ourselves when we are in the pulpit, who am I to announce the bread of the word to these souls? Why have I entered this pulpit? It is to beget them for Jesus Christ.' (FS 56:4)
